

TODAY'S GOSPEL

Jesus said to the chief priests and the elders of the people: "Hear another parable. There was a landowner who planted a vineyard, put a hedge around it, dug a wine press in it, and built a tower. Then he leased it to tenants and went on a journey. When vintage time drew near, he sent his servants to the tenants to obtain his produce. But the tenants seized the servants and one they beat, another they killed, and a third they stoned. Again he sent other servants, more numerous than the first ones, but they treated them in the same way. Finally, he sent his son to them, thinking, 'They will respect my son.' But when the tenants saw the son, they said to one another, This is the heir. Come, let us kill him and acquire his inheritance.'

GOSPEL REFLECTION

As he begins concluding his letter to the Philippians, Paul continues to exhort them to grow in their faith. If we place our trust in God, then "the peace of God...will guard your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus" (v.7). It is this confidence that allows Paul to suffer persecution, imprisonment and finally death. Paul knows that following the way of Christ ultimately leads to peace and so he encourages them to persevere in their faith.

Today's text from Isaiah serves as a background for Jesus' parable of the vineyard. Isaiah

addresses his parable to the people as a word of judgment. God has planted a vineyard with great care in Israel. Even the location, "a fertile hillside" (v.1) is intended to ensure a successful harvest. He "planted the choicest vines" (v.2) after preparing the soil. Yet, despite all this, it only yields "rotten grapes" (v.2). Isaiah warns the "inhabitants of Jerusalem" (v.3) that since "the vineyard of the Lord of hosts is the house of Israel" (v.7) and they have produced an undesirable harvest, they are about to face God's judgment.


Jesus speaks of a "landowner who planted a vineyard...(and) leased it to tenants" (v.33). This landowner does everything he can to ensure that the land will produce a good harvest. But in his absence the tenants refuse to pay the rent and abuse the servants sent to "obtain his produce" (v.34). Even his son cannot get them to pay the rent; they, "seized him, threw him out of the vineyard, and killed him" (v.39). For Matthew's community these wicked tenants represent those who reject Jesus and who will have the kingdom "taken away from you and given to a people that will produce its fruit" (v.43). Jesus' parable is also one of judgment. Like the parable in Isaiah, it challenges us to "produce fruit" or face judgment.



For Reflection:

Is my life producing a desirable harvest for God? How has God helped me to provide a successful yield?

At St. Paul's, we encourage all of our parishioners to serve in some way as part of their life of faith. Our service both at Church and in the community helps us to live our parish vision of Fervent Disciples lovingly embracing Jesus present in the poor, the alienated and the spiritually hungry.



"Each must do as already determined, without sadness or compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver." These words of St. Paul to the Corinthians remind us that our giving ought to be planned and determined in a prayerful way...Welcome to Commitment Sunday and the last weekend of . Our annual stewardship effort concludes in our parish today. We have all spent some time over the last several weeks learning about stewardship, hearing how it changes lives and praying about our commitment to share our gifts with our parish. Just a reminder: If you have not brought your forms with you today, please do so next Sunday. (Or-There are additional commitment forms in the pew for those who forgot to bring theirs today.)

We have heard from our guest speakers, **Trevor Jones, Derek Gazal and Patricia O'Connor** about what stewardship means to them, and how they live their lives based on stewardship. Thank you for sharing your experience with all of us here at St. Paul's. Stewardship as we have learned is based on the spiritual principles of the Old Testament and the teachings of Jesus. We have learned that those who have adopted stewardship have had their lives changed.

And, we have learned that stewardship is a way of life. It is a way of thanking God for all His blessings by our returning a portion of the time, talent and treasure given to us. Stewardship deepens our relationship with the Lord and brings each of us a sense of peace and joy. Jesus promises us that by practicing stewardship we will grow spiritually. There are many references in the Bible to stewardship. In one of those, Jesus tells us," You can be sure that whoever gives even a drink of cold water to one of the least of my followers, will certainly receive a reward." (Matthew 10:37-42) That reward also involves a growing trust in God's divine will. Symbolically we give a drink of cold water when we make our time and talents, and our treasure available to our parish and to our community. Every parishioner is called to give a drink of cold water by supporting the parish as it brings Christ's healing touch to our faith community and to those it serves.

It seems that one of the great burdens Jesus had to carry during his life on earth was being continually misunderstood. And the one dimension of his ministry where he was so often misunderstood was his radically new understanding of kingship. From the earliest days of his ministry—his rejection of Satan's temptation that he become a worldly king, to his death on the cross beneath a sign that read: "Jesus, King of the Jews"— Jesus labored under a misunderstanding of what it meant to be a true king. So what kind of kingdom did Jesus have in mind? Could we not say it was a stewardship kingdom? Those who became his closest followers—his disciples and apostles—slowly, at first, and at times, quickly, grasped the true meaning of Christ's kingdom ministry. To be in this kingdom required his followers to become perfect stewards of all that had been given them. They had to recognize their gifts and the gifts of others as coming from God. And they had to learn to use them day after day to build up a kingdom of peace and mercy—a kingdom of love.

Our parish family is blessed with many different members, each of whom has special talents and abilities that can benefit our parish. Today, we bring forth our gifts in God's name. What was true for the earliest members of this stewardship kingdom remains true for us today. To enter this kingdom, we must embrace fully stewardship as a way of life.






